Abstracts

You may submit abstracts for either a short communication, a poster, or a workshop. You may choose to submit and present in either Danish or in English.

NEW deadline for submission of abstracts: 22 August.

In the **short communication** sessions, each presenter will have 10 minutes to share a teaching experience and reflections followed by 10 minutes of discussion.

Poster presentations will be held in Campustorvet with 5 minutes presentations followed by short discussions.

Applications for posters can be supplemented with the wish to hold a participant activating **workshop** in the afternoon on the same theme covered in the poster.

Participant activating workshops can also be held without a preceding poster presentation.

Abstracts must be submitted in Word format: See www.sdu.dk/en/tal2022 for abstract information and download of abstract template.

All abstracts will be peer reviewed prior to acceptance or rejection.

Presenters will subsequently have the possibility of submitting a paper on their presentation for the conference proceedings.

Conference language: The morning keynote and the afternoon panel discussion will be in English. There will be parallel sessions in English and in Danish.
